**\*Notes for 4th year Vet Med Tuition & Fees**

-Resident rate charged for 4 credits or less for Fall, Spring and Summer semesters.

-Most students will not pay the health fee for 0-4 credits. See exceptions.

-Books and supplies are additional out-of-pocket expenses. The average cost for books and supplies per semester is \$520. Costs typically range between \$320 to \$720 per semester, depending on a student's major and class load.

-Room and board are additional out-of-pocket expenses. The average cost per semester is \$3,861.
